ALTER GAY was born in Hingham, Mass., in 1856. He is a pupil of Bonnât in Paris. His awards include: Honorable mention, Paris Salon, 1885; third-class medal, Paris Salon, 1888; gold medal, Vienna, 1893; gold medals, Antwerp and Munich, 1894; gold medals, Berlin and Buda-Pesth, 1895; silver medal, Exposition Universelle, Paris, 1900: silver medal. Pan-American Exposition, Buffalo, 1901. He is a Chevalier and Officer of the Legion of Honor, and is a member of the Societe des Peintres et des Sculpteurs (formerly the Societe Nouvelle). Societe de la Peinture à l'Eau, the Royal Society of Water Colors, Brussels, the National Institute of Arts and Letters. and is an Associate of the Societe Nationale des Beaux-Arts. He is represented in the Luxembourg Museum. Paris, (the French government having bought six of his works); the Museum at Amiens, France, the Pinakothek, Munich; the Metropolitan Museum of Art, New York; the Boston Museum of Fine Arts; the Pennsylvania Academy of the Fine Arts, Philadelphia; The Buffalo Fine Arts Academy, Albright Art Gallery; Carnegie Institute, Pittsburgh; the Rhode Island School of Design, Providence, besides many important private collections.

Having accomplished an artistic evolution that is easily followed in his works, Mr. Gay has abandoned the composition of ancient genre pictures to depict instead the effects of nature and modern interiors, as seen through a very personal temperament.
