BIOGRAPHICAL NOTE

A.J. Kloha was Manager, Engineering and Planning Department, Engine and Foundry Division, Ford Motor Company. As such, he was involved in the construction planning of the Lima (Ohio) Engine Plant.

HISTORICAL NOTE

The Lima Engine Plant was built in Lima, Ohio in 1955 as part of the reorganization program at Ford Motor Company after World War II. Under the leadership of Henry Ford II, some of the older plants were converted to other uses and new plants were added to increase production. The Lima plant was to supply engines to the Midwest area assembly plants.

SCOPE AND CONTENT NOTE

The collection consists of a single notebook which contains the design requirements for construction and changes made. Included are plans, engineering data and specifications.
